4. The task force shall:

- (1) Conduct studies on local, statewide, and national programs with demonstrated success at increasing positive social relationships with law enforcement agencies and youth;
- (2) Make recommendations to law enforcement agencies, communities, and schools as to programs, projects, activities, and events that will aid in developing a harmonious rapport between law enforcement officers and youth;
- (3) Advise the commissioner of education and the department of education on issues relating to the establishment of community relations programs in communities located in a county with a charter form of government and with more than nine hundred fifty thousand inhabitants that contain school districts with a total minority student population that exceeds fifty percent;
- (4) Make recommendations for a state plan for community education that sets forth the goals and objectives of a community relations program and establishes a system of priorities for targeting available resources on the areas with the greatest need within a school district;
- (5) Make recommendations for establishing community schools within communities containing community relations programs; and
- (6) Make recommendations for the funding of local community relations programs and projects, activities, and events that will aid in developing a harmonious rapport between law enforcement officers and youth.
- 5. For purposes of subsection 4 of this section, "community school", means a school that makes its facilities available for citizen use, coordinates activities of local citizens in identifying program needs and establishing priorities, identifies and utilizes available program resources, and assists in the initiation of programs to improve the cultural, social, recreational, and educational opportunities available in a community."; and
