1 AMEND House Bill No. 1608, Page 1, In the Title, Lines 2 and 3, by deleting the words "pain  
2 management clinics" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "the regulation of controlled  
3 substances"; and

5 Further amend said bill, Pages 1 and 2, Section 197.600, Lines 1 through 43, by deleting all of said  
6 section and lines from the bill and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

8 "195.430. 1. There is hereby established in the state treasury the "Controlled Substance  
9 Abuse Prevention Fund", which shall consist of all fees collected by the department of health and  
10 senior services for the issuance of registrations to manufacture, distribute, or dispense controlled  
11 substances. The state treasurer shall be custodian of the fund. In accordance with sections 30.170  
12 and 30.180, the state treasurer may approve disbursements. The fund shall be a dedicated fund and  
13 moneys in the fund shall be used solely for the operation, regulation, enforcement, and educational  
14 activities of the bureau of narcotics and dangerous drugs. Notwithstanding the provisions of section  
15 33.080 to the contrary, any moneys remaining in the fund at the end of the biennium shall not revert  
16 to the credit of the general revenue fund. The state treasurer shall invest moneys in the fund in the  
17 same manner as other funds are invested. Any interest and moneys earned on such investments  
18 shall be credited to the fund.

19 2. All fees authorized to be charged by the department shall be transmitted to the  
20 department of revenue for deposit in the state treasury for credit to the fund, to be disbursed solely  
21 for the payment of operating expenses of the bureau of narcotics and dangerous drugs to conduct  
22 inspections, enforce controlled substances laws and regulations, provide education to health care  
23 professionals and the public, and to prevent abuse of controlled substances.

24 3. Any moneys appropriated or made available by gift, grant, bequest, contribution, or  
25 otherwise to carry out the purposes of this section shall be paid to and deposited in the controlled  
26 substances abuse prevention fund.

27 195.435. The bureau of narcotics and dangerous drugs shall employ no less than one  
28 investigator for every one hundred controlled substance registrants."; and

30 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
31 accordingly.
