1 AMEND House Bill No. 1576, Page 1, In the Title, Line 3, by deleting the words "the commission
2 on capitol security infrastructure" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "public infrastructure"; and
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4 Further amend said bill, Page 3, Section 8.177, Line 21, by inserting after all of said section and
5 line, the following:
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7 "8.821. 1. The provisions of this section shall be referred as the "Energy Benchmark
8 Transparency Act".

9 2. Beginning September 1, 2016, the energy and water consumption of each permanent
10 public building in the state for which an Energy Star rating system exists shall be measured and
11 tracked and have benchmarks established utilizing the Environmental Protection Agency's online
12 Energy Star Portfolio Manager. Data contained in the Portfolio Manager shall annually be reported
13 to the division of energy located within the department of economic development. Data reported
14 under this section shall be published on the division of energy's website. The division of energy
15 shall collect and review all data collected and shall rank all public buildings based on the score
16 received from the Portfolio Manager. The ten public buildings receiving the highest scores shall be
17 recognized and honored by the division of energy. The owner of each public building shall be
18 responsible for implementing the provisions of this section.

19 3. The division of energy may promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this section.
20 Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is created under the
21 authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to
22 all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter
23 536 are nonseverable, and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter
24 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held
25 unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after
26 August 28, 2016, shall be invalid and void.

27 4. The provisions of this section shall expire September 1, 2026."; and
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29 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
30 accordingly.
