Fiscal Analysis

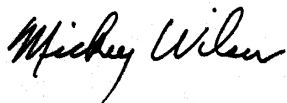

Officials at the **Boone County Sheriff's Department**, the **Cole County Sheriff's Department**, the **Springfield Police Department**, the **Jefferson City Police Department** and the **Columbia Police Department** each assume no fiscal impact to their respective entities from this proposal.

Officials from the Buchanan County Sheriff's Department, Clark County Sheriff's Department, Independence Police Department, Jackson County Sheriff Department, Platte County Sheriff's Department, St. Charles Police Department, St. Joseph Police Department, St. Louis County Police Department and the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.

FISCAL ANALYSIS (continued)

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
