FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Oversight was unable to receive some of the agency responses in a timely manner due to the short fiscal note request time. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information that we have or on prior year information regarding a similar bill. Upon the receipt of agency responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval of the chairperson of the Joint Committee on Legislative Research to publish a new fiscal note.

Oversight notes this proposal requires the Department of Higher Education to create guidance regarding notice of public employee eligibility for public service loan forgiveness. Oversight notes this proposal requires all school district to provide the said notice to all employees. Oversight assumes the creation and dissemination of the notice can be done using the school district's existing resources.

Officials at the **Department of Higher Education** assume that creation of the guidance notice can be done with existing staff and resources.

Officials at the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE)** assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposal. DESE defers to the school district for any fiscal impact they may experience.

Officials at the **Kansas City, New Haven, Macon County R-IV, Malta Bend, Pettis County R-XII, West Plains and Wright City R-II** school districts each assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION
