FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Oversight was unable to receive some of the agency responses in a timely manner due to the short fiscal note request time. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information that we have or on prior year information regarding a similar bill. Upon the receipt of agency responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval of the chairperson of the Joint Committee on Legislative Research to publish a new fiscal note.

Oversight notes this proposal would require superintendents and assistant superintendents to be employed by written contract. Oversight is unable to determine if any superintendents or assistant superintendents do not currently have a written contract. Oversight assumes this would not have a fiscal impact on school districts.

Officials at the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE)** assume no fiscal impact to the department. DESE defers to the school districts for any fiscal impact.

Officials at the **Kansas City, Malta Bend, Macon County R-IV, Pettis County R-XII, West Plains** and the **Webster Groves** school district each assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION
