Fiscal Analysis

Oversight was unable to receive some of the agency responses in a timely manner due to the short fiscal note request time. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information that we have or on prior year information regarding a similar bill. Upon the receipt of agency responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval of the chairperson of the Joint Committee on Legislative Research to publish a new fiscal note.

Officials at the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** assume no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Oversight assumes the next general election in which the election of chief juvenile officers could take place would be in November of 2018. At that time, Oversight assumes the various boards of election commissioners and the Secretary of State would submit this issue to the voters at the statewide general election and could absorb the cost. Therefore, Oversight will assume no direct fiscal impact from this proposal.
