AN ACT

To repeal section 478.705, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the twenty-sixth judicial circuit.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 478.705, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 478.705, to read as follows:

478.705. 1. There shall be two circuit judges in the twenty-sixth judicial circuit [consisting of the counties of Camden, Laclede, Miller, Moniteau and Morgan]. These judges shall sit in divisions numbered one and two. **Division one shall consist of the counties of Miller, Moniteau, and Morgan, and division two shall consist of the counties of Camden and Laclede.**

2. The circuit judge in division two shall be elected in 1980. The circuit judge in division one shall be elected in 1982.
