

HB 1671 -- TEXT MESSAGING WHILE DRIVING

SPONSOR: Kratky

Currently, anyone 21 years of age or younger is prohibited from texting while operating a moving motor vehicle on any highway in Missouri. This bill removes the age limit and prohibits anyone operating a noncommercial vehicle from texting while driving unless the device allows for voice-recognition hands-free texting and is being used in that manner.

This bill is the same as HB 27 (2015).
