

HB 1791 -- EXECUTIVE ORDERS

SPONSOR: Remole

This bill specifies that any federal regulation, rule or memorandum promulgated as a result of an executive order of the President of the United States and without a basis in federal statute or the constitutional authority of the President cannot be used to modify, change, or extend a federal law or regulation and such presidential executive orders are null and void. This bill does not infringe the President's authority to regulate the internal affairs of executive branch agencies or other federal agencies by executive order.
