1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 174, Page 3, Section 188.125, Line 68, by  
2 inserting after all of said line the following:

3 "188.345. 1. For purposes of this section, the term "medically accurate and unbiased  
4 information" shall mean information that is:

5 (1) Verified or supported by the weight of medical research conducted in compliance with  
6 accepted scientific methods;

7 (2) Recognized as correct and objective by leading medical organizations with relevant  
8 expertise or government agencies, such as the:

9 (a) American Medical Association;

10 (b) American Congress of Obstetricians and Gynecologists;

11 (c) American Public Health Association;

12 (d) American Academy of Pediatrics;

13 (e) American College of Physicians;

14 (f) American Academy of Family Physicians;

15 (g) Centers for Disease Control and Prevention;

16 (h) Food and Drug Administration;

17 (i) National Cancer Institute;

18 (j) American Psychological Association; or

19 (k) National Institute for Health; or

20 (3) Recommended by or affirmed in the medical practice guidelines of a nationally  
21 recognized accrediting organization, such as the:

22 (a) Joint Commission;

23 (b) National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA);

24 (c) American Accreditation HealthCare Commission or Utilization Review Accreditation  
25 Commission (AAHC/URAC); or

26 (d) Accreditation Association for Ambulatory Health Care (AAAHC).

27 2. For purposes of this section, the term "pregnancy-related services" shall mean services  
28 including, but not limited to, family planning, abortion care, prenatal care, labor and delivery, and  
29 postpartum care, and services provided by crisis pregnancy centers or alternatives to abortion  
30 agencies.

31 3. To be eligible to receive state funding, all organizations that provide pregnancy-related  
32 services or counseling shall provide medically accurate and unbiased information on all relevant  
33 reproductive health options including, but not limited to, information about birth control, pregnancy,  
34 adoption, labor and delivery, and postpartum care."; and
