1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 642, Page 1, Section A, Line 2, by  
2 inserting immediately after all of said section and line the following:

4 "173.1450. 1. The provisions of this section shall be known and may be referred to as the  
5 "College Credit Disclosure Act".

6 2. Except as provided in subsection 4 of this section, institutions of higher education located  
7 within the state that grant college-level credit but are not accredited by a regional accrediting body  
8 recognized by the United States Department of Education shall disclose during the admission  
9 application process, in writing, that the institution has not achieved regional accreditation  
10 recognized by the department.

11 3. The disclosure required in subsection 2 of this section shall be provided to an enrolling  
12 student prior to registering for any class granting credit, and the student shall sign the disclosure,  
13 either in writing or electronically, acknowledging receipt of such disclosure. The disclosure  
14 provided shall contain the following wording, in no less than fourteen-point font:

15 "College level credits earned at (Institution name) may not be transferrable to other higher  
16 learning/postsecondary learning institutions, including, but not limited to, universities, colleges,  
17 junior colleges, community colleges, or trade schools accredited by a regional accrediting body  
18 recognized by the United States Department of Higher Education.

19 Contact the institution receiving the transferred credit(s) for more information."

20 4. Notwithstanding any provision of this section or any other law, institutions of higher  
21 education affiliated with religious organizations that are accredited by a national faith-related  
22 accrediting organization recognized by the United States Department of Education shall be exempt  
23 from the disclosure requirements of this section."; and

25 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
26 accordingly.
