1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill Nos. 1194 & 1193, Page 7, Section 288.062,  
2 Line 207, by inserting immediately after said line the following:

3 "290.502. 1. Except as may be otherwise provided pursuant to sections 290.500 to 290.530,  
4 effective January 1, [2007] 2018, every employer shall pay to each employee wages at the rate of  
5 [~~\$6.50~~] \$10.00 per hour, or wages at the same rate or rates set under the provisions of federal law as  
6 the prevailing federal minimum wage applicable to those covered jobs in interstate commerce,  
7 whichever rate per hour is higher. Such wage per hour shall be increased to \$11.25 on January 1,  
8 2019; to \$12.50 on January 1, 2020; to \$13.75 on January 1, 2021; and to \$15.00 on January 1,  
9 2022.

10 2. The minimum wage shall be increased or decreased on January 1, [2008] 2019, and on  
11 January [±] first of successive years, by the increase or decrease in the cost of living. On September  
12 30, [2007] 2018, and on each September [30] thirtieth of each successive year, the director shall  
13 measure the increase or decrease in the cost of living by the percentage increase or decrease as of  
14 the preceding July over the level as of July of the immediately preceding year of the Consumer  
15 Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers (CPI-W) or successor index as published  
16 by the U.S. Department of Labor or its successor agency, with the amount of the minimum wage  
17 increase or decrease rounded to the nearest five cents."; and

19 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
20 accordingly.
