**Bill Summary:** This proposal requires the Commissioner of Administration to procure a

blanket bond or crime insurance policy to protect the state against loss from the acts or omissions of any state-compensated person within the

judiciary.

### Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Attorney General's Office** assume any potential cost arising from this proposal can be absorbed with existing resources.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
