FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Missouri Department of Transportation** assume this proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Officials from **St. Francois County** stated this proposal would save the county twenty five percent of the taxes collected in the city which will allow the county to maintain the county roads. County officials estimated the savings from the City of Farmington would be \$130,000 for 2016.

Oversight will assume for fiscal note purposes, this proposal would have no net effect on local governments although it may reduce revenues for one local government and increase revenues for another.
