FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Revenue (DOR)** assume this proposal would, beginning January 1, 2018, require any entity that bids on publically funded projects to submit a statement of "no tax due" with the bid.

Administrative Impact

DOR officials assume Sales Tax would require one additional Revenue Processing Technician I (Range 10, Step L) for additional "no tax due" correspondence.

In total, the DOR estimate of cost to implement this proposal including the additional employee and related equipment and expense was \$46,053 for FY 2018, \$47,085 for FY 2019, and \$47,468 for FY 2020.

Oversight assumes existing DOR staffing would be adequate to implement this proposal. If unanticipated additional costs are incurred, or if multiple proposals are implemented that increase DOR costs or the workload for DOR employees, resources could be requested through the budget process.

Officials from the **Office of Administration - Division of Budget and Planning** stated that while this proposal would not directly impact general and Total State Revenues, it could have a positive impact if it results in more people paying taxes already owed to the state.

Oversight will include in this fiscal note a positive fiscal impact for the state funds which receive sales tax revenue and for local governments. **Oversight** will show the impact as \$0 to Unknown for the potential additional filers.

Officials from the **Bakersfield R-IV School District** assume this proposal could have a minimal fiscal impact to their organization.

Officials from the **Forsyth R-III School District** assume this proposal could have a positive fiscal impact to their organization.
