FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Department of Higher Education** assume this would require the re-write of 6 CSR 10-3.010, which can be done with existing resources.

Officials at the **Missouri Western State University** assume a negative impact of less than \$2,000.

Officials at the **Metropolitan Community College** assume a minimal to non-existent impact.

Officials at the **State Technical College of Missouri** assume the impact is unknown.

Officials at the **Missouri State University, Truman State University, University of Central Missouri** and the **University of Missouri** each assume there is no fiscal impact from this proposal to their respective institutions.

Officials at the following colleges: Crowder, East Central Community College, Harris-Stowe, Jefferson College, Lincoln University, Moberly Area Community College, Missouri Southern State University, Northwest Missouri State University, Southeast Missouri State University, State Fair Community College, St. Charles Community College, St. Louis Community College and the Three Rivers Community College did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION


The proposed legislation appears to have no direct fiscal impact.
