### AN ACT

To amend chapter 311, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to intoxicating liquor licensees.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 311, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 311.367, to read as follows:

**311.367. 1. The provisions of this section shall apply to all persons, firms, or corporations who own and operate more than one premises licensed to sell intoxicating liquor containing alcohol in excess of five percent by weight at retail.**

**2. Any person, firm, or corporation described in subsection 1 of this section, with the permission of the supervisor of liquor control, may designate one or more places as a central warehouse to which intoxicating liquors ordered and purchased by a person, firm, or corporation from licensed wholesalers may be delivered by licensed wholesalers and at which intoxicating liquors so owned by a person, firm, or corporation may be stored.**

**3. Any person, firm, or corporation described in subsection 1 of this section who owns and stores intoxicating liquors in a central warehouse may transfer all or any part of the intoxicating liquors so stored from the central warehouse to any premises licensed to sell intoxicating liquors at retail which is owned and operated by the same person, firm, or corporation and which is located in the state; provided, however, that no malt liquor shall be transferred from the central warehouse to another licensed premises unless the licensed premises is located in the same designated geographic area of the wholesaler from whom the malt liquor was purchased.**
