

HB 320 -- CRIMINAL NONSUPPORT

SPONSOR: Neely

This bill specifies that a driver's license issued by the Department of Revenue is not subject to suspension or revocation due to the non-payment of a child support obligation.

This bill specifies that any person found guilty of criminal nonsupport must not receive any jail time as a part of his or her sentence, and authorizes the court to order the offender to perform community service.

This bill is similar to HB 2692 (2016).
