

HB 394 -- CHARGING PROSTITUTION

SPONSOR: Adams

This bill prohibits a prosecutor from charging prostitution as a felony offense if at the time of the crime the offender was under the control of an agent.

If a person was previously charged with felony prostitution, he or she may request a court hearing to be heard on the issue of whether that prostitution charge may be expunged because he or she was acting under the authority of an agent at the time of the offense.

This bill is similar to HB 2511 (2016).
