

HB 595 -- EARNED COMPLIANCE CREDITS

SPONSOR: McGaugh

This bill specifies that no offender shall be discharged from probation, parole, or conditional release under the provisions of this bill if, at the final discharge date, the offender owes unpaid court costs or has other unfulfilled conditions of probation, parole, or conditional release, unless specifically authorized by the sentencing court. No offender ordered by the court to pay restitution shall be released from probation, parole, or conditional release until such restitution is complete.

This bill is the same as SB 177 (2017).
