

HB 895 -- INSPECTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

SPONSOR: Hill

This bill changes the inspection required for beer or other malt liquors as well as spirituous liquors. This bill requires manufacturers, producers, and wholesale or retail dealers of beer or malt liquor sold in this state to first provide the supervisor of liquor control a copy of a certificate of label approval issued by the Federal Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau which verifies the alcohol content of the product. Manufacturers, distillers, and wholesale or retail dealers of spirituous liquors sold in this state must first provide the supervisor of liquor control a copy of a certificate of label approval issued by the Federal Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau which verifies the alcohol content of the product. The supervisor of liquor control shall no longer be required to inspect all beer, malt liquor, and spirituous liquor manufactured, brewed, or distilled in this state.
