

HB 1141 -- INTOXICATING LIQUOR

SPONSOR: Fraker

This bill specifies that any person, firm, or corporation who owns and operates more than one premise licensed to sell intoxicating liquor at retail may, with the permission of the supervisor of liquor control, designate one or more places as a central warehouse in which liquor purchased from a wholesaler may be delivered and stored. The liquor stored in such warehouses may then be transferred to any premise in the state licensed to sell intoxicating liquor at retail which is owned and operated by the same person, firm, or corporation. However, malt liquor can only be transferred from the central warehouse to a licensed premises located in the same designated geographic area of the wholesaler from whom the malt liquor was purchased.
