1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 1457, Page 1, Section A, Line 2, by
2 inserting after all of said section and line the following:

3 "161.072. 1. The state board of education shall meet semiannually in December and in June
4 in Jefferson City. Other meetings may be called by the president of the board on seven days' written
5 notice to the members. In the absence of the president, the commissioner of education shall call a
6 meeting on request of three members of the board, and if both the president and the commissioner
7 of education are absent or refuse to call a meeting, any three members of the board may call a
8 meeting by similar notices in writing. The business to come before the board shall be available by
9 free electronic record at least seven business days prior to the start of each meeting. All records of
10 any decisions, votes, exhibits, or outcomes shall be available by free electronic media within forty-
11 eight hours following the conclusion of every meeting. Any materials prepared for the members of
12 the board by the staff shall be delivered to the members at least five days before the meeting, and to
13 the extent such materials are public records as defined in section 610.010 and are not permitted to
14 be closed under section 610.021, shall be made available by free electronic media at least five
15 business days in advance of the meeting.

16 2. The public shall be granted a public comment period during every state board of
17 education meeting under this section.

18 3. Each meeting of the state board of education shall be recorded by video, and such video
19 recording shall be posted to the website of the department of elementary and secondary education
20 within forty-eight hours following the conclusion of every meeting.

21 4. The department of elementary and secondary education shall archive the video recordings
22 described under subsection 3 of this section on its website in a manner that ensures easy and free
23 accessibility by members of the public. Such recordings shall be retained, destroyed, or disposed of
24 in a manner that is consistent with the procedures established by the state records commission
25 created under section 109.250.

26 5. The department of elementary and secondary education shall not require members of the
27 public to create an account, register, or provide any personally identifiable information in order to
28 view the video recordings described under subsection 3 of this section. The department shall not
29 collect, retain, sell, or otherwise use or make publicly accessible personally identifiable information
30 of any member of the public viewing any such video recording.

31 6. Each member of the state board of education shall have an individual email address that
32 shall be made available to members of the public. Any member of the public may email a member
33 of the state board of education at such email address."; and

35 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
