2 of said page, by inserting after all of said line the following:

3 "26.235. Whenever a vacancy exists in the office of
 4 lieutenant governor, the governor shall immediately appoint, with
 5 the advice and consent of the senate, a person to fill such
 6 vacancy for the remainder of the term in which the vacancy
 7 occurred, who shall continue in office until a successor shall
 8 have been duly elected and qualified pursuant to article IV of
 9 the Missouri constitution."; and

10 Further amend said bill, page 2, section 105.030, line 11 of
 11 said page, by striking "lieutenant governor,"; and

12 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
