1 AMEND Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 549, Page 1,
2 Section A, Line 3, by inserting immediately after all of said section and line the following:

4 "178.931. 1. Beginning July 1, 2018, and thereafter, the department of elementary and
5 secondary education shall pay monthly, out of the funds appropriated to it for that purpose, to each
6 sheltered workshop a sum equal to the amount calculated under subsection 2 of this section but at
7 least the amount necessary to ensure that at least twenty-one dollars is paid for each six-hour or
8 longer day worked by a handicapped employee.

9 2. In order to calculate the monthly amount due to each sheltered workshop, the department
10 shall:

11 (1) Determine the quotient obtained by dividing the appropriation for the fiscal year by
12 twelve; and

13 (2) Divide the amount calculated under subdivision (1) of this subsection among the
14 sheltered workshops in proportion to each sheltered workshop's number of hours submitted to the
15 department for the preceding calendar month.

16 3. The department shall accept, as prima facie proof of payment due to a sheltered
17 workshop, information as designated by the department, either in paper or electronic format. A
18 statement signed by the president, secretary, and manager of the sheltered workshop, setting forth
19 the dates worked and the number of hours worked each day by each handicapped person employed
20 by that sheltered workshop during the preceding calendar month, together with any other
21 information required by the rules or regulations of the department, shall be maintained at the
22 workshop location."; and

24 Further amend said bill, Page 14, Section 620.2020, Line 213, by inserting immediately after all of
25 said section and line the following:

27 ~~"[178.930. 1. (1) Beginning July 1, 2009, and until June 30, 2010, the department~~
28 ~~of elementary and secondary education shall pay monthly, out of the funds~~
29 ~~appropriated to it for that purpose, to each sheltered workshop a sum equal to ninety~~
30 ~~dollars for each standard workweek (Monday through Friday) of up to and including~~
31 ~~thirty hours worked during the preceding calendar month. Eighteen dollars shall be~~
32 ~~paid for each six-hour or longer day worked by a handicapped employee on~~
33 ~~Saturdays or Sundays. For each handicapped worker employed by a sheltered~~
34 ~~workshop for less than a thirty-hour week or a six-hour day on Saturdays or Sundays,~~
35 ~~the workshop shall receive a percentage of the corresponding amount normally paid~~

1 (2) Beginning July 1, 2010, and thereafter, the department of elementary and
2 secondary education shall pay monthly, out of the funds appropriated to it for that
3 purpose, to each sheltered workshop a sum equal to ninety-five dollars for each
4 standard workweek (Monday through Friday) of up to and including thirty hours
5 worked during the preceding calendar month. Nineteen dollars shall be paid for each
6 six-hour or longer day worked by a handicapped employee on Saturdays or Sundays.
7 For each handicapped worker employed by a sheltered workshop for less than a
8 thirty-hour week or a six-hour day on Saturdays or Sundays, the workshop shall
9 receive a percentage of the corresponding amount normally paid based on the
10 percentage of time worked by the handicapped employee.

11 2. The department shall accept, as prima facie proof of payment due to a sheltered
12 workshop, information as designated by the department, either in paper or electronic
13 format. A statement signed by the president, secretary, and manager of the sheltered
14 workshop, setting forth the dates worked and the number of hours worked each day
15 by each handicapped person employed by that sheltered workshop during the
16 preceding calendar month, together with any other information required by the rules
17 or regulations of the department, shall be maintained at the workshop location.

18 3. There is hereby created in the state treasury the "Sheltered Workshop Per Diem
19 Revolving Fund" which shall be administered by the commissioner of the department
20 of elementary and secondary education. All moneys appropriated pursuant to
21 subsection 1 of this section shall be deposited in the fund and expended as described
22 in subsection 1 of this section.

23 4. The balance of the sheltered workshop per diem revolving fund shall not exceed
24 five hundred thousand dollars at the end of each fiscal year and shall be exempt from
25 the provisions of section 33.080 relating to the transfer of unexpended balances to the
26 general revenue fund. Any unexpended balance in the sheltered workshop per diem
27 revolving fund at the end of each fiscal year exceeding five hundred thousand dollars
28 shall be deposited in the general revenue fund.]

30 Section B. Because immediate action is necessary to ensure that as many people can be
31 employed in sheltered workshops as possible, and that the employment of people can occur as soon
32 as possible, the repeal of section 178.930 and the enactment of section 178.931 of this act is deemed
33 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, welfare, peace, and safety, and is
34 hereby declared to be an emergency act within the meaning of the constitution, and the repeal of
35 section 178.930 and the enactment of section 178.931 of this act shall be in full force and effect on
36 July 1, 2018, or upon its passage and approval, whichever occurs later."; and
