1 AMEND House Amendment No. _____ to Senate Bill No. 757, Page 2, Line 19, by deleting all of
2 said line and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4 "driver's license with a school bus endorsement.

5 304.060. 1. The state board of education shall adopt and enforce regulations not
6 inconsistent with law to cover the design and operation of all school buses used for the
7 transportation of school children when owned and operated by any school district or privately
8 owned and operated under contract with any school district in this state, and such regulations shall
9 by reference be made a part of any such contract with a school district. The state board of education
10 may adopt rules and regulations governing the use of other vehicles owned by a district or operated
11 under contract with any school district in this state and used for the purpose of transporting school
12 children. The operator of such vehicle shall be licensed in accordance with section 302.272, and
13 such vehicle shall transport no more children than the manufacturer suggests as appropriate for such
14 vehicle. The state board of education may also adopt rules and regulations governing the use of
15 authorized common carriers for the transportation of students on field trips or other special trips for
16 educational purposes. Every school district, its officers and employees, and every person employed
17 under contract by a school district shall be subject to such regulations. The state board of education
18 shall cooperate with the state transportation department and the state highway patrol in placing
19 suitable warning signs at intervals on the highways of the state.

20 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 1 of this section, any school board in the
21 state of Missouri in an urban district containing the greater part of the population of a city which has
22 more than three hundred thousand inhabitants may contract with any municipality, bi-state agency,
23 or other governmental entity for the purpose of transporting school children attending a grade or
24 grades not lower than the ninth nor higher than the twelfth grade, provided that such contract shall
25 be for additional transportation services, and shall not replace or fulfill any of the school district's
26 obligations pursuant to section 167.231. The school district may notify students of the option to use
27 district contracted transportation services.

28 3. Any officer or employee of any school district who violates any of the regulations or fails
29 to include obligation to comply with such regulations in any contract executed by him on behalf of a
30 school district shall be guilty of misconduct and subject to removal from office or employment.
31 Any person operating a school bus under contract with a school district who fails to comply with
32 any such regulations shall be guilty of breach of contract and such contract shall be cancelled after
33 notice and hearing by the responsible officers of such school district.
