1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 1999, Page 1, Section A, Line 2, by  
2 inserting immediately after said section and line the following:

4 "247.200. 1. The district shall have the right to lay its mains in public highways, roads,  
5 streets and alleys included in the district, but the same shall be done under reasonable rules and  
6 regulations of governmental bodies having jurisdiction of such public places. This shall apply to  
7 maintenance and repair jobs. In the construction of ditches, laying of mains, filling of ditches after  
8 mains are laid, connection of service pipes and repairing of lines, due regard must be taken of the  
9 rights of the public in its use of thoroughfares and the equal rights of other utilities thereto.

10 2. No district shall require a secondary deposit from commercial property owners. For the  
11 purposes of this subsection, a commercial property is a property that is zoned for commercial use by  
12 the zoning authority that has jurisdiction over the property.

13 3. If a water meter has been removed from a property or if services to a property have been  
14 discontinued, no future charges may be made to the customer for service to that property. Any  
15 charges made after service is discontinued or the water meter is removed shall be credited to the  
16 customer and applied toward any future charges to such customer by the district.

17 247.285. 1. No metropolitan water supply district shall require a secondary deposit from  
18 commercial property owners. For the purposes of this subsection, a commercial property is a  
19 property that is zoned for commercial use by the zoning authority that has jurisdiction over the  
20 property.

21 3. If a water meter has been removed from a property or if services to a property have been  
22 discontinued, no future charges shall be made to the customer for service to that property. Any  
23 charges made after service is discontinued or the water meter is removed shall be credited to the  
24 customer and applied toward any future charges to such customer by the metropolitan water supply  
25 district."; and
