1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 2540, Page 157, Section 144.014, Line
2 17, by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "144.016. 1. Beginning October 1, 2018, the tax levied and imposed under sections
5 144.010 to 144.527 and sections 144.600 to 144.746 on all retail sales of feminine hygiene products
6 and diapers shall be levied at a rate that shall not exceed the sales tax levied on the retail sale of
7 food.

8 2. For purposes of this section, the following terms mean:

9 (1) "Diapers", absorbent garments worn by infants or toddlers who are not toilet-trained or
10 by individuals who are incapable of controlling their bladder or bowel movements;

11 (2) "Feminine hygiene products", tampons, pads, liners, and cups."; and

13 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
14 accordingly.
