1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 2540, Page 408, Section 644.032, Line
2 42, by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "Section 1. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary and beginning on
5 January 1, 2020, the department of revenue shall permanently suspend the imposition of all
6 registration fee charges, for all types of motor vehicles which are passenger vehicles eligible for
7 highway use, and shall, in lieu thereof, impose an annual registration fee for each motor vehicle
8 type based upon passenger vehicle age. The department shall set the annual registration fees as
9 follows:

10 (1) For passenger vehicles less than or equal to five years old since purchase, the
11 registration fee shall be one hundred twenty dollars;

12 (2) For passenger vehicles more than five years old, but less than or equal to ten years old
13 since purchase, the registration fee shall be one hundred seven dollars and fifty cents;

14 (3) For passenger vehicles more than ten years old, but less than or equal to fifteen years old
15 since purchase, the registration fee shall be ninety-two dollars and fifty cents;

16 (4) For passenger vehicles more than fifteen years old, but less than or equal to twenty years
17 old since purchase, the registration fee shall be seventy-seven dollars and fifty cents;

18 (5) For passenger vehicles more than twenty years old, but less than or equal to twenty-five
19 years old since purchase, the registration fee shall be fifty-seven dollars;

20 (6) For passenger vehicles more than twenty-five years old since purchase, the registration
21 fee shall be fifty dollars.

22 The department shall implement rules with exact registration fee charges for motor vehicle
23 types by January 1, 2019, but such rules shall not take effect until January 1, 2020.

24 2. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is created
25 under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is
26 subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and
27 chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to
28 chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently
29 held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after
30 August 28, 2018, shall be invalid and void."; and

32 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
