FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration (DIFP)** assume this proposal increases certain fees authorized under state law that are paid by insurance companies to do business in Missouri. Based upon FY2017 counts, the DIFP expects to collect an additional \$2,210,314 in revenue per fiscal year in the Insurance Dedicated Fund.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This bill modifies the fee requirements for every individual or entity making a filing with the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration. These fees will be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of the insurance dedicated fund.

This proposal has an effective date of January 1, 2019.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
