AN ACT

To repeal section 71.286, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to regulation of the display of the United States flag.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 71.286, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 71.286, to read as follows:

71.286. Notwithstanding any other provision of the law to the contrary, no state law, city, town, [øf] village, **political subdivision, or special district** ordinance shall regulate the exhibition of a properly displayed United States flag. For the purposes of this section, the term "properly displayed" shall mean that the flag contains no additional design or embellishment and is displayed consistent with the provisions of Title 4 U.S.C. Sections 1-10, pursuant to the normally accepted guidelines for the display of the United States flag.
