### AN ACT

To repeal section 589.426, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to sexual offender restrictions, with a penalty provision.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 589.426, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 589.426, to read as follows:

589.426. 1. Any person required to register as a sexual offender under sections 589.400 to 589.425 shall ~~[be required]~~ **avoid all Halloween-related contact with children, and on** October thirty-first of each year ~~[to]~~:

(1) ~~[Avoid all Halloween-related contact with children;~~

~~—(2)]~~ Remain inside his or her residence between the hours of 5 p.m. and 10:30 p.m. unless required to be elsewhere for just cause~~[-]~~ including, but not limited to, employment or medical emergencies;

~~[(3)]~~ (2) Post a sign at his or her residence stating, "No candy or treats at this residence"; and

~~[(4)]~~ (3) Leave all outside residential lighting off during the evening hours after 5 p.m.

2. Any person required to register as a sexual offender under sections 589.400 to 589.425 who violates the provisions of subsection 1 of this section shall be guilty of a class A misdemeanor.
