## AN ACT

To amend chapter 168, RSMo, by adding thereto two new sections relating to school employee salaries.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 168, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto two new sections, to be  
2 known as sections 168.215 and 168.216, to read as follows:

3 **168.215. 1. Except as provided in subsection 3 of this section, no school district**  
4 **shall enter into a new contract or a contract renewal with a superintendent or equivalent**  
5 **highest-ranking executive after August 28, 2018, that provides a salary and benefit package**  
6 **for the superintendent or highest-ranking executive that is in excess of an amount equal**  
7 **to three times the salary and benefits that the superintendent or equivalent highest-ranking**  
8 **executive would receive, based on his or her educational experience and background, if**  
9 **such school district hired him or her to be a classroom teacher in the district.**

10 **2. Any taxpayer of the school district shall have standing to bring a cause of action**  
11 **for a violation of this section.**

12 **3. The provisions of this section shall not apply to any metropolitan school district**  
13 **or school district located in a home rule city with more than four hundred thousand**  
14 **inhabitants and located in more than one county.**

15 **168.216. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the names,**  
16 **salaries, and job titles of all public school employees shall be reported by each school**  
17 **district to the newspaper with the largest circulation within the municipality or county in**
