## AN ACT

To amend chapter 9, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to historically black college and university week.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 9, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 9.170, to read as follows:

3 **9.170. The third week of September shall be known as “Historically Black College**  
4 **and University Week.” The citizens of this state are encouraged to observe the week with**  
5 **appropriate events and activities recognizing the importance of historically black colleges**  
6 **and universities, especially Lincoln University and Harris-Stowe State University, the two**  
7 **historically black colleges and universities located in Missouri.**
