AN ACT

To repeal section 177.086, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to construction of facilities authorized by school districts.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 177.086, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 177.086, to read as follows:

177.086. 1. **Except as otherwise provided in this section,** any school district authorizing the construction of facilities which may exceed an expenditure of fifteen thousand dollars shall publicly advertise, once a week for two consecutive weeks, in a newspaper of general circulation, qualified pursuant to chapter 493, located within the city in which the school district is located, or if there be no such newspaper, in a qualified newspaper of general circulation in the county, or if there be no such newspaper, in a qualified newspaper of general

- circulation in an adjoining county, and may advertise in business, trade, or minority newspapers,
- 8 for bids on said construction.
 - 2. No bids shall be entertained by the school district which are not made in accordance with the specifications furnished by the district and all contracts shall be let to the lowest responsible bidder complying with the terms of the letting, provided that the district shall have the right to reject any and all bids.
 - 3. All bids must be submitted sealed and in writing, to be opened publicly at time and place of the district's choosing.
 - 4. Any school district with an average daily attendance, as defined in section 163.011, of more than four thousand in the school year preceding the school year in which the district enters into a contract for construction of facilities shall be exempt from the
