JOINT RESOLUTION

Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri an amendment repealing section 2(a) of article IX of the Constitution of Missouri, and adopting one new section in lieu thereof relating to terms of office of members of the state board of education.

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring therein:

That at the next general election to be held in the state of Missouri, on Tuesday next
2 following the first Monday in November, 2018, or at a special election to be called by the
3 governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted to the qualified voters of this state, for
4 adoption or rejection, the following amendment to article IX of the Constitution of the state of
5 Missouri:

Section A. Section 2(a), article IX, Constitution of Missouri, is repealed and one new
2 section adopted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 2(a), to read as follows:

Section 2(a). The supervision of instruction in the public schools shall be vested in a
2 state board of education, consisting of eight lay members appointed by the governor, by and with
3 the advice and consent of the senate; provided, that at no time shall more than four members be
4 of the same political party. The term of office of each member shall be ~~eight~~ **four** years, except
5 ~~[the terms of the first appointees shall be from one to eight years, respectively]~~ **as otherwise**
6 **provided by general law**. While attending to the duties of their office, members shall be
7 entitled to receive only actual expenses incurred, and a per diem fixed by law.

Section B. Under section 116.155 and other applicable constitutional provisions and laws
2 of this state authorizing the general assembly to adopt ballot language for the submission of a
3 joint resolution to the voters of this state, the official ballot title of the amendment proposed in
4 section A shall be as follows:

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

5 "Shall the Constitution of Missouri be amended to reduce the terms of office for members
6 of the state board of education from eight years to four years, except as otherwise provided by
7 general law?".
