JOINT RESOLUTION

Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri an amendment to article I of the Constitution of Missouri, by adding thereto one new section relating to department of conservation resident landowner privileges.

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring therein:

That at the next general election to be held in the state of Missouri, on Tuesday next
2 following the first Monday in November, 2018, or at a special election to be called by the
3 governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted to the qualified voters of this state, for
4 adoption or rejection, the following amendment to article I of the Constitution of the state of
5 Missouri:

Section A. Article I, Constitution of Missouri, is amended by adding thereto one new
2 section, to be known as section 37, to read as follows:

**Section 37. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, any United States
2 citizen who is not a resident of Missouri but owns at least seventy-five acres of property in
3 Missouri may receive the same hunting, fishing, and trapping privileges as a resident
4 landowner.**
