

HB 1831 -- BACK TO SCHOOL SALES TAX HOLIDAY

SPONSOR: Ruth

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Ways and Means by a vote of 9 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Rules-Administrative Oversight Committee by a vote of 12 to 0 and 1 voting present.

This bill clarifies that disposable diapers are included in the items exempted from sales tax during the Back to School Sales Tax Holiday in August each year.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that while the Department of Revenue considers diapers as clothing for the sales tax holiday, this bill clarifies that decision.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Ruth.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
