

HB 2235 -- CIVILIAN REVIEW BOARDS

SPONSOR: Newman

This bill requires each county in the state to establish a civilian review board with the authority to investigate allegations of misconduct by local law enforcement officers toward members of the public. The bill specifies the powers and duties of the civilian review boards. The board shall submit to the chief law enforcement official its findings and recommendations, and the chief law enforcement official shall refer the cause to a special prosecutor for further evaluation.
