

HB 2431 -- CHARTER SCHOOLS

SPONSOR: Unsicker

This bill requires a charter school to compensate a noncharter public school for certain educational services provided to a student who has transferred from a noncharter public school to a charter school, and then transferred back to a noncharter public school in the same district as the original noncharter public school. The charter school shall compensate the noncharter public school if the student received special educational services before, during, and after his or her attendance of the charter school, and the student regressed during his or her attendance at the charter school. The charter school shall pay the amount necessary to pay for all expenses associated with the compensatory educational services required for the student to correct for any regression or performance gap that occurred during his or her attendance. The Department of Elementary and Secondary Education shall resolve any dispute between the schools about the amount owed.
