1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill Nos. 26 & 922, Page 1, Section A, Line 6, by  
2 inserting after said section and line the following:

4 "115.063. 1. When any question or candidate is submitted to a vote by any political  
5 subdivision or special district and no other question or candidate is submitted at the same election,  
6 all costs of the election shall be paid from the general revenue of the political subdivision or special  
7 district submitting a question or candidate at the election.

8 2. All costs of elections involving a statewide candidate or statewide issue and all costs of  
9 elections involving candidates for state senator or state representative shall be paid by the state,  
10 except that if a political subdivision or special district holds an election on the same day, the costs  
11 shall be shared proportionately by the state and the political subdivisions and special districts  
12 affected in the manner provided in section 115.065.

13 3. When a proposed political subdivision submits a petition requesting an election as part of  
14 the formation thereof, the petitioners shall submit together with the petition sufficient security to pay  
15 all costs of the election. If such proposition is successful, the political subdivision thereby created  
16 shall reimburse those persons advancing funds to pay the costs of the election.

17 4. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the state shall, subject to  
18 appropriation, pay election costs for elections conducted under section 115.065."; and

20 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
21 accordingly.
