1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 147,
2 Page 1, Section A, Line 3, by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "136.055. 1. Any person who is selected or appointed by the state director of revenue as
5 provided in subsection 2 of this section to act as an agent of the department of revenue, whose duties
6 shall be the processing of motor vehicle title and registration transactions and the collection of sales
7 and use taxes when required under sections 144.070 and 144.440, and who receives no salary from
8 the department of revenue, shall be authorized to collect from the party requiring such services
9 additional fees as compensation in full and for all services rendered on the following basis:

10 (1) For each motor vehicle or trailer registration issued, renewed, or ~~transferred—three~~
11 ~~transferred, six dollars [and fifty cents]~~ and ~~[seven]~~ twelve dollars for those licenses sold or
12 biennially renewed pursuant to section 301.147;

13 (2) For each application or transfer of ~~[title—two]~~ title, six dollars [and fifty cents];

14 (3) For each instruction permit, nondriver license, chauffeur's, operator's, or driver's license
15 issued for a period of three years or ~~[less—two]~~ less, six dollars [and fifty cents] and ~~[five]~~ twelve
16 dollars for licenses or instruction permits issued or renewed for a period exceeding three years;

17 (4) For each notice of lien ~~[processed—two]~~ processed, six dollars [and fifty cents];

18 (5) ~~[No]~~ Notary fee or ~~[other fee or additional charge shall be paid or collected except for]~~
19 electronic ~~[telephone]~~ transmission ~~[reception—two]~~ per processing, two dollars.

20 2. The director of revenue shall award fee office contracts under this section through a
21 competitive bidding process. The competitive bidding process shall give priority to organizations
22 and entities that are exempt from taxation under Section 501(c)(3), 501(c)(6), or 501(c)(4), except
23 those civic organizations that would be considered action organizations under 26 C.F.R. Section
24 1.501 (c)(3)-1(c)(3), of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, with special consideration
25 given to those organizations and entities that reinvest a minimum of seventy-five percent of the net
26 proceeds to charitable organizations in Missouri, and political subdivisions, including but not
27 limited to, municipalities, counties, and fire protection districts.

28 Points shall be allocated based upon the distance of an applicant's residential address, provided on
29 his or her Missouri income tax form, from the fee license office in which he or she seeks an
30 ownership interest in the following manner:

31 (1) If located less than thirty-five miles from the license office address, then an additional
32 twenty percent of total points available;

33 (2) If located thirty-five miles or more, but less than seventy-five miles from the license
34 office address, then an additional ten percent of total points available; and

35 (3) If located seventy-five miles or more from the license office address, then no additional
36 points shall be awarded.

1 The director of the department of revenue may promulgate rules and regulations necessary to carry
2 out the provisions of this subsection. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section
3 536.010, that is created under the authority delegated in this subsection shall become effective only
4 if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section
5 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the
6 general assembly pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and
7 annul a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any
8 rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2009, shall be invalid and void.

9 3. All fees collected by a tax-exempt organization may be retained and used by the
10 organization.

11 4. All fees charged shall not exceed those in this section. The fees imposed by this section
12 shall be collected by all permanent offices and all full-time or temporary offices maintained by the
13 department of revenue.

14 5. Any person acting as agent of the department of revenue for the sale and issuance of
15 registrations, licenses, and other documents related to motor vehicles shall have an insurable interest
16 in all license plates, licenses, tabs, forms and other documents held on behalf of the department.

17 6. The fees authorized by this section shall not be collected by motor vehicle dealers acting
18 as agents of the department of revenue under section 32.095 or those motor vehicle dealers
19 authorized to collect and remit sales tax under subsection 8 of section 144.070.

20 7. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the state auditor may audit all
21 records maintained and established by the fee office in the same manner as the auditor may audit
22 any agency of the state, and the department shall ensure that this audit requirement is a necessary
23 condition for the award of all fee office contracts. No confidential records shall be divulged in such
24 a way to reveal personally identifiable information."; and
