1 AMEND Senate Bill No. 20, Page 1, Section A, Line 2, by inserting after said section and line the
2 following:

4 "217.930. 1. (1) Medical assistance under MO HealthNet shall be suspended, rather than
5 cancelled or terminated, for a person who is an offender in a correctional center if:

6 (a) The department of social services is notified of the person's entry into the correctional
7 center;

8 (b) On the date of entry, the person was enrolled in the MO HealthNet program; and

9 (c) The person is eligible for MO HealthNet except for institutional status.

10 (2) A suspension under this subsection shall end on the date the person is no longer an
11 offender in a correctional center.

12 (3) Upon release from incarceration, such person shall continue to be eligible for receipt of
13 MO HealthNet benefits until such time as the person is otherwise determined to no longer be
14 eligible for the program.

15 2. The department of corrections shall notify the department of social services:

16 (1) Within twenty days after receiving information that a person receiving benefits under
17 MO HealthNet is or will be an offender in a correctional center; and

18 (2) Within forty-five days prior to the release of a person who is qualified for suspension
19 under subsection 1 of this section.

20 221.125. 1. (1) Medical assistance under MO HealthNet shall be suspended, rather than
21 cancelled or terminated, for a person who is an offender in a county jail, a city jail, or a private jail
22 if:

23 (a) The department of social services is notified of the person's entry into the jail;

24 (b) On the date of entry, the person was enrolled in the MO HealthNet program; and

25 (c) The person is eligible for MO HealthNet except for institutional status.

26 (2) A suspension under this subsection shall end on the date the person is no longer an
27 offender in a jail.

28 (3) Upon release from incarceration, such person shall continue to be eligible for receipt of
29 MO HealthNet benefits until such time as the person is otherwise determined to no longer be
30 eligible for the program.

31 2. City, county, and private jails shall notify the department of social services within ten
32 days after receiving information that a person receiving medical assistance under MO HealthNet is
33 or will be an offender in the jail."; and
