1 AMEND Senate Bill No. 20, Page 1, Section A, Line 2, by inserting after all of said section and line
2 the following:

4 "210.1014. 1. There is hereby created the "Amber Alert System Oversight Committee",
5 whose primary duty shall be to develop criteria and procedures for the Amber alert system and shall
6 be housed within the department of public safety. The committee shall regularly review the function
7 of the Amber alert system and revise its criteria and procedures in cooperation with the department
8 of public safety to provide for efficient and effective public notification and meet at least annually to
9 discuss potential improvements to the Amber alert system. As soon as practicable, the committee
10 shall adopt criteria and procedures to expand the Amber alert system to provide urgent public alerts
11 related to homeland security, criminal acts, health emergencies, and other imminent dangers to the
12 public health and welfare.

13 2. The Amber alert system oversight committee shall consist of ten members of which seven
14 members shall be appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the senate. Such
15 members shall represent the following entities: two representatives of the Missouri Sheriffs'
16 Association; two representatives of the Missouri Police Chiefs Association; one representative of
17 small market radio broadcasters; one representative of large market radio broadcasters; one
18 representative of television broadcasters. The director of the department of public safety shall also
19 be a member of the committee and shall serve as chair of the committee. Additional members shall
20 include one representative of the highway patrol and one representative of the department of health
21 and senior services. Notwithstanding the provisions of this subsection, any Amber alert system
22 oversight committee member, other than the director of the department of public safety and law
23 enforcement committee members, may alternatively be a representative of the outdoor advertising
24 industry, a representative of the Missouri broadcasters association, or a representative of the public
25 at large; except that no more than one committee member shall be a representative of the outdoor
26 advertising industry, no more than one committee member shall be a representative of the Missouri
27 broadcasters association, and no more than one committee member shall be a representative of the
28 public at large.

29 3. Members of the oversight committee shall serve a term of four years, except that
30 members first appointed to the committee shall have staggered terms of two, three, and four years
31 and shall serve until their successor is duly appointed and qualified.

1 4. Members of the oversight committee shall serve without compensation, except that
2 members shall be reimbursed for their actual and necessary expenses required for the discharge of
3 their duties.

4 5. The Amber alert system oversight committee shall promulgate rules for the
5 implementation of the Amber alert system. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in
6 section 536.010, that is created under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective
7 only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable,
8 section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested
9 with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date or to
10 disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking
11 authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2003, shall be invalid and void.

12 6. Amber alerts issued in this state may include an embedded Uniform Resource Locator
13 (URL) that references a resource on the internet that provides additional information or
14 technological capabilities.

15 7. (1) The provisions of this subsection shall be known and may be cited as the "Honing
16 Alerts Issued by Law Enforcement for Youth Safety Act," or "HAILEY'S Law".

17 (2) The Amber alert system shall be integrated into the Missouri uniform law enforcement
18 system (MULES) and the Regional Justice Information Service (REJIS) to expedite the reporting of
19 child abductions.

20 8. The Amber alert system oversight committee shall submit a report to the general
21 assembly on or before January 1, 2020, and annually thereafter, regarding the activities and rules
22 promulgated throughout the preceding year. The report shall include the following:

23 (1) The changes in criteria and procedures for the Amber alert system;

24 (2) The Amber alert system oversight committee's review of the function of the Amber alert
25 system;

26 (3) The meeting notices and minutes;

27 (4) A list of members;

28 (5) Reimbursements; and

29 (6) Any new rules promulgated."; and

31 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
32 accordingly.
