1 AMEND Senate Bill No. 20, Page 1, Section A, Line 2, by inserting after all of said section and line
2 the following:

4 "320.091. There shall be no cause of action against any fire protection district, volunteer fire
5 protection association, or any fire department of any political subdivision, company, or organization
6 ~~[which]~~ that donates equipment used to suppress fire or fire protection clothing to another
7 department, association, ~~[or]~~ district, or fire training academy if one of the following conditions
8 ~~[are]~~ is met:

9 (1) ~~[Such equipment is approved by the state fire marshal or the state fire marshal's~~
10 ~~designee;~~

11 ~~_____ (2) Motor vehicles so donated must pass a safety inspection by the Missouri state highway~~
12 ~~patrol;~~

13 ~~_____ (3) The [receiving agency demonstrates to the state fire marshal's office] recipient certifies~~
14 ~~to the donor at the time of donation that the equipment received works properly; [and] or~~

15 ~~[(4) (2) The donor [agency] informs the [receiving agency] recipient in writing of any~~
16 ~~defects in the equipment or clothing about which it [knows] knew or, by using ordinary care, could~~
17 ~~have known at the time of donation.~~

19 This immunity shall apply only to causes of action directly related to the equipment or clothing
20 mentioned in this section."; and

22 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
