1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 374, Page 121, Section 94.1012, Line 57,
2 by inserting all of the following after said line:

3 "144.016. 1. Beginning October 1, 2019, the tax levied and imposed under chapter 144 on
4 all retail sales of feminine hygiene products, diapers, and incontinence products shall be levied at a
5 rate that shall not exceed the sales tax levied on the retail sale of food.

6 2. For purposes of this section, the following terms mean:

7 (1) "Diapers", absorbent garments worn by infants or toddlers who are not toilet-trained or
8 by individuals who are incapable of controlling their bladder or bowel movements;

9 (2) "Feminine hygiene products", tampons, pads, liners, and cups;

10 (3) "Incontinence products", products designed specifically for hygiene matters related to
11 urinary incontinence, including but not limited to, adult diapers."; and

13 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
14 accordingly.
