1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 581, Page 8, Section 160.400, Line 218,
2 by inserting after all of said line the following:

3
4 "160.404. For purposes of sections 160.400 to 160.425, "underperformance",
5 "underperforms", or "underperformed" means the receipt of scores demonstrating that the
6 percentage of students who perform proficient and advanced on the annual statewide system of
7 assessments under section 160.518 in English language arts and mathematics in a charter school is
8 lower than the average percentage of grade-level-equivalent students attending attendance centers in
9 the school district in which the charter school is located who perform proficient and advanced in
10 English language arts and mathematics; except that, the receipt of such scores shall not result in the
11 term "underperformance", "underperforms", or "underperformed" being applied to a charter school
12 if the charter school is a school in which:

13 (1) Fifty percent or more of the school's students were previously considered dropouts under
14 subdivision (5) of subsection 2 of section 160.405; or

15 (2) The average rate of growth in English language arts and mathematics on the annual
16 statewide system of assessments under section 160.518 based on the state's growth model for the
17 charter school's students is higher than the average rate of growth in English language arts and
18 mathematics based on the state's growth model for grade-level-equivalent students attending
19 attendance centers in the school district in which the charter school is located."; and

21 Further amend said bill, Page 13, Section 160.405, Lines 195-201 by deleting all of said lines and
22 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

24 "addressing the requirements of sections 160.400 to 160.425 and 167.349; and

25 (9) Seek to ensure that the percentage of its students who perform proficient and advanced
26 on the annual statewide system of assessments under section 160.518 in English language arts and
27 mathematics is equal to or higher than the average percentage of grade-level-equivalent students
28 attending attendance centers in the school district in which it is located who perform proficient and
29 advanced in English language arts and mathematics."; and

31 Further amend said bill and section, Page 15, Lines 249-266 by deleting all of said lines and
32 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

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34 "a. Clear evidence of underperformance as demonstrated in the charter school's annual
35 performance report in three of the last four school years; or"; and

1 Further amend said bill, page, and section, Lines 274-275, by deleting all of said lines and inserting
2 in lieu thereof the following:

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4 "b. Underperformance for at least two years;"; and

6 Further amend said bill and section, Pages 16-17, Lines 311-314, by deleting all of said lines and
7 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

9 "(b) The charter school has underperformed for two of the three consecutive years
10 immediately before a decision whether to renew the school's charter is made;"; and

11
12 Further amend said bill and section, Pages 17-18, Lines 344-349, by deleting all of said lines and
13 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

15 "(e) If a charter school underperforms for two of the three consecutive years immediately
16 before a decision whether to renew the school's charter is made, any renewal granted shall be for
17 only a three-year term. If the charter school again underperforms for two years of the three-year
18 term, the school's charter shall not be renewed."; and

20 Further amend said bill and section, Page 18, Line 380, by inserting after all of said line the
21 following:

23 "160.407. 1. For the purpose of this section, the term "student mobility" shall mean the
24 number of students who either enrolled in or withdrew from a Missouri public school local
25 educational agency during the school year divided by the total school enrollment numbers not
26 including a change of schools due to academic promotion.

27 2. The department of elementary and secondary education shall conduct a student mobility
28 study for all public school local educational agencies. The study shall analyze student mobility by
29 local educational agency and by school building, and shall include data on the next local educational
30 agency and school building to which students transfer. The study shall be made available on the
31 department's official website."; and

33 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
34 accordingly.
