1 AMEND House Bill No. 338, Page 1, Section 9.117, Line 4, by inserting after said section and line  
2 the following:

4 "9.196. May nineteenth of each year shall be known and is designated as "Malcolm X  
5 Observation Day" in Missouri in honor of Malcolm X, a human rights activist and courageous  
6 advocate for the rights of African Americans who articulated concepts of equality and self-  
7 determination. It is recommended to the people of the state that the day be appropriately observed  
8 through activities and events designed to celebrate the life of Malcolm X, raise awareness about his  
9 legacy in the civil rights movement, and encourage the end of violence, crime, substance abuse, and  
10 self-loathing that continue to cripple low-income urban communities.

11 9.197. May nineteenth of each year shall be known and is designated as "El-Hajj Malik El-  
12 Shabazz Observation Day" in Missouri in honor of El-Hajj Malik El-Shabazz, a human rights  
13 activist and courageous advocate for the rights of African Americans who articulated concepts of  
14 equality and self-determination. It is recommended to the people of the state that the day be  
15 appropriately observed through activities and events designed to celebrate the life of El-Hajj Malik  
16 El-Shabazz, raise awareness about his legacy in the civil rights movement, and encourage the end of  
17 violence, crime, substance abuse, and self-loathing that continue to cripple low-income urban  
18 communities."; and
