1 AMEND Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 230, Page 6,  
2 Section 475.115, Line 18, by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "479.080. 1. In the prosecution of violations of municipal ordinances before a municipal  
5 judge, all fines and costs shall be paid to and deposited not less frequently than monthly into the  
6 municipal treasury.

7 2. In the prosecution of violations of municipal ordinances before an associate circuit judge,  
8 all fines shall be ~~paid to and deposited not less frequently than monthly into the municipal treasury~~  
9 ~~and]~~ sent to the director of the department of revenue and shall be distributed annually to the schools  
10 of the county in the same manner that proceeds of all penalties, forfeitures and fines collected for  
11 any breach of the penal laws of the state are distributed. All court costs shall be accounted for and  
12 remitted to the state treasury in the same manner as provided by law for costs in misdemeanor cases.

13 3. The supreme court by administrative rule may provide for uniform procedure, and  
14 reporting forms for the collection and transmittal of fines and costs. Until modified or otherwise  
15 provided by such administrative rule, the municipal judge, or associate circuit judge hearing and  
16 determining violations of municipal ordinances, shall cause the clerk serving his division, within the  
17 first ten days of every month, to make out a list of all the cases heard or tried before the judge  
18 during the preceding month, giving in each case the name of the defendant, the fine imposed, if any,  
19 the amount of costs, the names of defendants committed and the cases in which there was an  
20 application for trial de novo, respectively. Such clerk or the judge shall verify such lists and  
21 statements by affidavit, and file the same forthwith with the clerk of the municipality, who shall lay  
22 the same before the governing body or the municipality at its first session thereafter. The official  
23 collecting fines shall, within the ten days aforesaid, pay to the municipal treasurer the full amount of  
24 all fines collected by him during the preceding month if not previously paid to the municipal  
25 treasurer."; and

27 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
28 accordingly.
